

PRIVACY POLICY

In MAS D'EN BRUNO, S.L. (hereinafter, "MdB"), we are aware of the importance of respecting the privacy required by current regulations and we are committed to protecting the security, integrity, veracity and confidentiality of all the personal data of users that we process.

Through this Privacy Policy we inform you about how we collect, treat and protect your personal data when accessing our website, in addition to providing you with information about your rights, regarding privacy and the protection provided by current regulations.

1. WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TREATMENT?

2. FOR WHAT PURPOSE DO WE TREAT YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

Through this website, we will process your personal data for the following purposes:

- Where appropriate, process and manage your request for information about our services through the contact form provided for this purpose.
- If you have given your consent to do so, send you informative publications and newsletters about our services.
- Manage the information provided by the technical cookies installed on the website, as reported in our Cookies Policy.

In addition, MdB informs you that in no case do we make automated decisions that produce legal effects on you or that affect you in a similar way.

3. LEGITIMATE BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA:

The legitimate basis for the processing of your personal data is your consent for the specified purposes.

However, we inform you that the installation of technical cookies does not require the user's consent (for more information on this, you can consult our Cookies Policy).

In the same way, we will treat your data to comply with applicable legal obligations, including but not limited to, the management of the response when you exercise your personal data protection rights.

4. COMMUNICATION OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA:

Your data may be communicated to third parties, solely and exclusively to guarantee the provision of the services we offer you. For this purpose, MdB will not share any personal data without your consent for different purposes, unless there is a legal obligation.

Likewise, we will not transfer your personal data outside the European Economic Area, and in the event that on some occasion they could be made, you will be informed in advance of said transfer and it will be carried out, in any case, in accordance with current data protection regulations.

5. FOR HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

At MdB we keep your personal data only for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes for which they were collected.

However, when we need your consent, the data will be kept until you withdraw that consent. In this sense, we will respect the applicable legal prescription periods, limiting them to what is strictly necessary for the purposes of the treatment. Subsequently, MdB will block your personal data to prevent their processing, unless it is necessary to make them available to the Public Administrations, Courts, Arbitration and Mediation Entities, for the fulfillment of the obligations

6. WHAT RIGHTS PROTECT YOU IN RELATION TO THE PROCESSING OF YOUR DATA?

You have the right to obtain information about the treatment that MdB makes of your personal data. In particular you have the following rights:

- **Right of access to your personal data.** This right allows you to receive a copy of the personal data we process about you to check that we are lawfully processing your data.
- **Right to rectify your personal data.** In the event that the information collected about you is incomplete or inaccurate, you have the right to ask us to correct it.
- **Right to delete your personal data.** You may request the deletion of your personal information in cases where your data is no longer required to carry out the purpose for which it was collected, when you withdraw your consent in cases where this is the legitimate basis of the treatment, always you. opposes and other reasons do not prevail, when your data is treated illegally or in cases where the deletion responds to compliance with a legal obligation.
- **Right to the portability of your personal data.** You have the right to receive the personal data that concerns you, that you have provided to MdB, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to transmit them to another data controller without being prevented by the data controller to whom they were provided. , when: the treatment is based on consent according to article 6, paragraph 1, letter a), or article 9, paragraph 2, letter a), or on a contract according to article 6, paragraph 1, letter b), and the treatment is carried out by automated means.
- **Right to object to the processing of your personal data** when we rely on a legitimate interest (or those of a third party) and there is something in your particular situation that makes you object to the processing for this reason, since you consider that it affects your rights. and fundamental freedoms.
- **Right to request the limitation of the processing of your personal data.** This allows you to ask us to suspend the processing of your personal data in the following cases (a) if you want us to establish the accuracy of the data; (b) where our use of the data is illegal but you do not want us to erase it; (c) where you need us to keep the data, even if we no longer need it because you need it to establish, exercise or defend legal claims; or (d) if

you have objected to us using your data, but we need to verify whether we have compelling legitimate grounds to use it.

- **Right to withdraw consent.** When the processing of personal data is based on your consent, you can withdraw it at any time. However, the withdrawal of consent will not affect the legality of the treatment prior to said withdrawal.

You also have the right to file a claim with the competent control authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the applicable legislation: www.aepd.es.
